Seventy Crore) only under Art 275 (1) of the Constitution of India for the financial year 2015-16, and out of this amount the following fund under Article 275(1) of the Constitution of India for the financial year 2015-16 has been received and credited to the Account of , WBSC & ST Development & Finance Corporation after getting concurrence from the Finance Department as stated below:

The guidelines in a nutshell of the Schemes under Art 275 (1) enclosed for your ready reference in Annexure II, and in this regard attention of all concern are drawn to the Detail Guidelines of MOTA of Art 275 (1) and SCA to TSP communicated vide Memo No: F. NO: 17019/01/2014- PC&V of MOTA Dated: 07.03.14, which is available in Website of MOTA. A copy of this circular has also been forwarded to you over e-mail communicated vide Memo No: SBCW-1020/14, dated 31.12.14 of Principal Secretary BCW.

The Governor is pleased to sanction an expenditure of Rs. 42, 17, 90,000/ (Forty-two Crore Seventeen Lakh and Ninety Thousand) only for different activities as stated in the Annexure I, out of the fund kept in the Account of West Bengal Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes Development and Finance Corporation for the benefit of ST people under Art 275 (1) for 2015-16 as stated above. The details of the Schemes also need to be discussed and approved in the meeting of the appropriate authority for information of all concern.

The different P.O. cum DWO, / DWOs will draw the amount out of Rs. 42, 17, 90,000/ (Forty-two Crore Seventeen Lakh and Ninety Thousand) only as stated in Annexure I and release the same to the concerned executing agencies for execution of the schemes as noted.

The Technical Agency executing the scheme should certify that the work has been done in accordance with the specific plan and estimates at the time of submission of the utilization certificate to this Department through the P.O. cum DWOs / DWOs.

On completion of the scheme, the utilization certificate in duplicate with a synopsis of the work done and photographs of the schemes should be submitted to the TD Department by the respective P.O. cum DWOs / DWOs.

The Managing Director, West Bengal Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes Development and Finance Corporation will place the fund of Rs. 42,17,90,000/ (Forty-two Crore Seventeen Lakh and Ninety Thousand) only at the disposal of the P.O. cum DWOs, / DWOs as stated in the Annexure I through the concerned District Manager of the Corporation for implementation of the scheme.

Before execution of the scheme from this fund, it has to be ensured that the fund from any other sources has not been received for executing the sanctioned scheme/work concerned. If any other fund is found to have been received for execution of the scheme, the fund sanctioned herein should be surrendered forthwith.

The Executing Agency will put up a signboard indicating that the scheme is funded under Art 275 (1) of the TD Department. The respective Executing Agency has to give certificate regarding completion of work etc.
